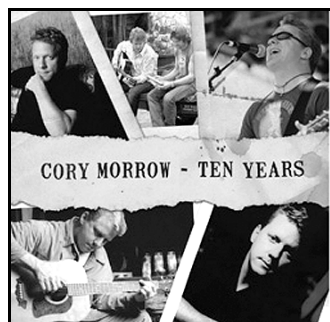

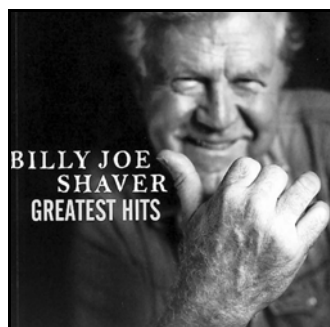
### Larry Joe Taylor - *Times*

He has been called "the Jimmy Buffet of the Redneck Riviera" and for good reason. Not just because of the party atmosphere his music and shows tend to nurture, but because Larry Joe Taylor has a unique way with words and melody and a way of taking the laid back side of life and giving it profound importance, ("Lazy Days"). Being clever is also a LJT calling card ("Too Much Rock"), as well as being able strike a chord on a listeners heartstrings without being sappy ("Times Square"). He also gets a little help from his friends on Times. Joining in on this project in one way or another are Mike McClure, Jerry Jeff Walker, Lloyd Maines, John Inmon, and Davin James, among others. If you look around and listen, there are plenty of performers out there writing songs about coastal living, Mexico, drinkin' and chance encounters such as described in "Monkey Rivertown Girl". It's just that so many Larry Joe and Buffet imitators and admirers don't dig any deeper than the surface to illustrate their experiences. A plain spoken poet, much like Hank Williams Sr., Billy Joe Shaver was, is, and continues to be a performer that has so much more to give the world of music. For those not all that familiar with the man and his music, Greatest Hits is a perfect starter for your Billy Joe Shaver collection.
